Overview of Maidstone Hickmotts

Pre-1835

To date we have only accessed the Maidstone All Saints registers and a few others covered by LDS. No Hickmotts appeared in the registers in the 1500s. All the Hickmotts registered in the 1600s and the first half of the 1700s were from elsewhere. The first local Hickmott to appear in the Maidstone All Saints register was a Susannah Hickmott who married Edward Gorman there in 1750 but seems not to have lived at Maidstone after her wedding.

The first Hickmott families to live in Maidstone were those of Henry and Mary Hickmott nee Nowell (married at All Saints in 1779) and Walter and Anne Hickmott nee Bishop(e) (married at All Saints in 1781). Although still to be confirmed, we think Henry and Walter may have been the sons of William and Elizabeth Hickmott nee Walter (who were married at Horsmonden in 1739). Henry and Walter had between them some eight children at Maidstone none of whom married or later lived there. Although still to be confirmed, we think that two other Hickmotts who had connections with Maidstone around this time were also the sons of William Hickmott and Elizabeth Walter:

- 1) Leonard Hickmott, who married Mary Maynard at Cranbrook in 1789 and later lived at Boxley (on the northern outskirts of Maidstone) where he had at least two children: Elizabeth Walter Hickmott (1791) and Anna Hickmott (1795). They may also have had a son, William Hickmott, who married Rebecca Nash at Boxley in 1811 and had four children we know of at Maidstone between 1812 and 1818; and
- 2) Thomas Hickmott, who married Esther Cook at Yalding in 1774 and had five children there. At least two of these were later married and had families at Maidstone:
 - 1) **Walter Hickmott** (1775-1860) who married **Mary Whyman** (1775-1844) in 1798 and had nine children there between 1798 and 1818. These included John Hickmott (1815-72) who married Harriet Jury (1821-1904) at Maidstone in 1840 and had at least eight children there. Two of these – William and Charles Hickmott – lived and had children at Maidstone in the 1880s and early 1890s. Another, Edward Hickmott (1850-), was a professional cricketer who played for a time for Kent.

- 2) **Henry Hickmott** who married **Elizabeth Chadwick** at Boxley in 1804 and had eight children at Maidstone between 1805 and 1822. Their son William Hickmott (1807-78) and his wife Eleanor Norburn had four children at Maidstone between 1844 and 1850.

Between 1800 and 1835 some eighteen (eleven male and seven female) Hickmotts were married at Maidstone. Continuing the pattern of earlier years, only one couple lived and had children at Maidstone: **William Hickmott** (1793-bef 1851) and **Elizabeth Sarah Cork** (1797-1863). They were married at All Saints in 1816 and had at least six children baptised there between 1817 and 1840, including: 1) William Hickmott (1817-68) whose son Walter and his wife Fanny Hubbard had six children at Maidstone between 1870 and 1883; and 2) Walter Hickmott (1832-72) who married Eleanor Dawes in the Maidstone RD in 1859 and had at least five children at Maidstone between 1860 and 1872.

Another couple to live and have children at Maidstone in this period was James Hickmott (1790-1846) and Ann Tolhurst who were married at Frittenden (James' place of birth) in 1820 and had four children we know of at Maidstone between 1823 and 1833.

Details of these various families are provided below.

Post-1835

The period 1835 to around 1900 saw a number of other Hickmotts live and have families at Maidstone. These included:

William Hickmott (1796-1860) and **Hannah Wingate** (1802-61) who were born respectively at Lamberhurst and Chatham, were married at Maidstone in 1821 and lived there towards the end of their lives. Two of their sons were also married at Maidstone and had children there:

- 1) Charles Thomas Hickmott (1823-85) who was born at Lamberhurst and married Hannah Lawrence Jupe (1828 –1906) at Maidstone in 1846. They had at least nine children at Maidstone between 1847 and 1864 including Charles William Hickmott (1847-95) who had at least 12 children at Maidstone between 1871 and 1891.
- 2) Alfred Edwin Hickmott (1836-1930) who was born at Staplehurst and married Elizabeth Woollett (1832-1917) in the Malling RD in 1858. They had at least nine children and four grandchildren at Maidstone over the period 1858 to 1888.

Two sons of John and Ann Hickmott nee Joy (who were married at West Farleigh in 1825 and lived all their lives there):

- 1) **William Hickmott** (1830-88) who was born at West Farleigh, married **Mary**

Ann Paine (1832-1902) from Chart Sutton in the Maidstone RD in 1856 and had at least ten children, eight of who were born and lived at Maidstone

- 2) John Hickmott who was born at West Farleigh in 1838, married Susannah Craddock (1840-1921) in the Maidstone RD in 1861 and had five children at Maidstone. These included: 1) Charles James Hickmott who married Olive Selina Cheeseman at Maidstone in 1893 and had at least five children there (plus three others); and 2) Wallace Howard Hickmott who married Edith Nissen in the Maidstone Rd in 1900 and had four children at Maidstone (plus three others).

Stephen Hickmott who married Emily Chapman at Biddenden in 1870 but later lived at Maidstone where they had seven children (plus another born at Cranbrook).

Details of the post 1835 Hickmotts are shown in the Maidstone RD Listings.

He and Mary appear to have lived all their lives at West Farleigh where they had at least nine children: John (1804)=Ann Joy, Stephen (1807)=Jane Parramore, Rebecca (1809)=John Pearson, William (1811), Charles (1813)=Mary Ann Maynard, Samuel (1816)=Caroline Waghorn, Jane Elizabeth (1822)=Thomas Fancett, Eliza (1824) and Caroline (1828).

Known children: James (1821, Frittenden, William (1823, Maidstone), Leonard (1829, Maidstone) and Charlotte (1833, Maidstone). The 1841 census has a James Hickmott (50) living on Water Lane in Maidstone with three of his children: James (20), Leonard (10) and Charlotte (8). The Maidstone parish registers show that James (56 of Water Lane Maidstone) died there in 1846. The 1851 census has the widowed Ann (60, born either in Kent or London) lodging in West Maidstone with Leonard (20 year-old groom) and Charlotte (17 year-old shoe binder).

Hannah was born at Chatham in Kent in around 1802. The censuses show that they had at least six children: Charles Thomas (1823, Lamberhurst), Harriet Hannah (1829, Chatham), William Richard (1833, Chatham), Karen (1834, Hendon M'sex), Alfred (1836, Staplehurst) and Hannah (1838, Staplehurst). We believe William died at Maidstone in 1860, Hannah died there a year later.

John died and was buried at Frittenden on 21 October 1861.

The LDS index shows that they also had baptized at Brenchley: Harriet (1827), Charles (1829), Charlotte (1830) and Benjamin (1837).

He and Sarah seemed to have lived at Marden, Boughton-Monchelsea and Bearsted after their marriage. We think that Henry may have died at Bearsted in 1850. The 1851 census shows the widowed Sarah (42, Marden) living on Church Lane at Bearsted. With her were: John (21), William (16), Edwin (12), Thomas (10), Charles (8), Alfred (5, Hucking), Sarah A. (2, Bearsted) and Mathew (3m, Bearsted). She was living on Bearsted Street Bearsted in 1861 together with Edwin, Thomas, Alfred, Sarah and Mathew. Her eldest son, John and his wife Sarah Ann (28, Maidstone) were living next door with their four children: Elizabeth (9), Henry (7), Sarah A. (5) and Caroline (2) where all were born at Bearsted. We think that Sarah was buried at Boughton-Monchelsea in

1865. Henry and Sarah's known children: John (1830, Marden), Henry (1832, Marden), William (1834, B-Monchel), Edwin (1838, B-Monchel), Thomas (1841, B-Monchel), Charles (1843, B-Monchel), Alfred (1846, Hucking), Sarah A. (1849, Bearsted) and Mathew (1851, Bearsted).
